## RULES

1. All Classes are open.
2. All entry forms to be sent to the Secretary by dates given on entry form.  
**Entries will be accepted on the day will be charged at double fee, at the discretion of the Show Secretary.**
3. All exhibits to be staged by 9.30 a.m. on the day of the Show, at which time all "unauthorised persons" must leave the hall. The hall will be open to stage exhibits on day of show from 6.00 a.m.
4. Exhibits not to be removed from the hall before prize giving.
5. Entries are accepted on the following conditions:
  - (a) All exhibits in Div 1 - 3 inclusive must have been grown by the exhibitor over a period of not less than two months immediately prior to the Show on, or in, his or her own garden or allotment.
  - (b) Members of Committee do have the right to visit and inspect any exhibitor's garden or allotment prior to the Show, or at any other time, to ensure that the Rules are not abused but strictly adhered to.
6. Judges will have the power to award less than three prizes in any class, the judge's decision as to the relative merits of exhibits shall be final.
7. An exhibitor breaking any rules may, at the discretion of the Committee, be disqualified from future Shows and the Committee reserve the right to refuse any entry without giving any reason or explanation.
8. **Exhibitors may make more than one entry in any class, but only take one prize in that class, except Division 8, Photography – 1 exhibit per exhibitor per class.**
9. Points awarded: 1<sup>st</sup>, 4; 2<sup>nd</sup>, 2; 3<sup>rd</sup>, 1.
10. Two or more persons may not exhibit for prizes separately from the same garden, nursery or plant house. This applies to divisions 1 – 3 inclusive.
11. Any objection by an exhibitor must be made in writing to the Secretary, with a deposit of 50p, by 3.00 p.m. on the day of the Show. The deposit will be returned if the committee decides that the protest is invalid, or was in good faith.
12. Prize monies will be paid out from 2.00 p.m. at close of show and prize money not collected one month after the Show date will be forfeited.
13. All exhibits will be at the risk of the exhibitor and while every care will be taken by the Committee, the Society shall not be liable for any loss or damage from any cause whatsoever.
14. The Show will be conducted in accordance with the Rules and Standards contained in Show Handbooks of R.H.S. and N.V.S. except where, under this schedule, they obviously do not apply.

4oz soft margarine      Topping:- 4 tablespoons lemon juice  
6oz caster sugar                      4 tablespoons granulated sugar  
2 eggs  
4 tablespoons milk  
6oz S R flour  
1 tsp baking powder  
Grated rind of 1 lemon

### **METHOD**

All in one method. Bake in 2lb loaf tin at 160C (fan oven) for 50 minutes.  
Immediately it comes out of the oven – prick all over and pour on topping.
