

The President's Thoughts

I well recall a meeting in 1974 of the community services committee of the Rotary club, when we discussed the fact that at the time Ledbury didn't have an annual show or carnival. This led to the holding of an open meeting in the community centre, for the general public, to discuss the format and date on which to hold any such event. The outcome was that it was agreed to hold a carnival and show on August Bank Holiday Monday, and it would involve as many organisations as possible. The selection of a venue for the show ground itself was discussed, and finally selected was Hazel Meadows, now largely occupied by commercial enterprises. This format continued successfully for a number of years until the development of these companies on the site. In 1985 and again in 1986, an alternative field was selected off the Bromyard road, at Priors Court. But that year turned out to be a very wet year and the conditions proved to be very 'challenging'!

After that experience it was agreed to change the format to a street carnival and contain it within the town, with charities and other organisations making their own plans within the overall Carnival programme, the first such event taking place in 1987.

This is still the plan that has been successfully followed every year to date, but it continues to rely on the enthusiastic involvement of a dedicated group, who are constantly looking for more help, so that Ledbury will continue to be able to hold an annual show and carnival for many years to come.

LEDBURY CARNIVAL Bank Holiday Monday 25th August 2014 **40 YEARS OF LEDBURY CARNIVAL ENTRY FOR CARNIVAL PROCESSION**

The Procession will start from Ledbury Rugby Club, travel up New Street to the Top Cross, through the High Street, along the Homend into Orchard Lane, finishing at the Primary School (1.6 miles). Entrants must arrive at Ledbury Rugby Club car park by 10am to allow time for judging and the procession to be marshalled for a 12.00 noon start. On arrival please book in at the desk.

The theme is 40 Years of Ledbury Carnival, although you may choose a different theme for your entry. Safety on a float must be paramount, particularly if there are young children aboard, one person should be nominated as responsible for safety. Water pistols are not allowed. If you are able to have music of any sort on your float, it all adds to the day!! All entries will be provided with official collection buckets for raising money for the Carnival and local organisations, all buckets and any money collected must be handed to one of the marshals at the end of the procession. NO other collection buckets are permitted.






