





LEDBURY HORTICULTURAL SOCIETY

Reproduced. First Published in 1978 Carnival Programme

For the last two years (1976-1978) our Society has organised the Flower Show held in conjunction with the Ledbury Carnival on August Bank Holiday Monday.

For many years our Society has been responsible for organising a Flower Show of one form or another in Ledbury. Looking back through the records of the Society, which date back to 1950, I noted that in his annual reports of 1952 the then Secretary, a Mr. Cummings, stated "In 1978 the Club has staged their 10th Annual Summer Show". Each year since a show or shows of one sort or another has been staged by this Society.

Again looking back to the annual report of 1955 the Secretary stated these words to the A.G.M. "This year's (1978) show I feel sure will go down as the biggest event staged in Ledbury for a great many years, and the 6,000 people who attended will, I trust, mark down the Ledbury Floral Fete as a must for 1956. The profit of £128 11s. 8d. I think is very satisfactory in the face of the ever increasing costs."

At the time all the entertainment was organised by the Society, the admission charges were 2/- for adults, 6d. for children over 5 years, 1/- for cars. 6d. for motor cycles.

As far as the records read, the show carried on in that form until 1964, with 1959 being the vintage year, when the records read 8,000 people attended & a total of 603 exhibits were received for the Flower Show.

After 1964 there appears to have been no outdoor show for two years, until 1967 and '68 when the show moved outdoors again, held in conjunction with the Ledbury Pony Show on a field opposite the present site, with reasonable support, but the amount of work and high cost of organising the show eventually overcame the Society and outdoor shows were abandoned indefinitely.

However shows were organised indoors at various venues, namely the Market House, Feathers Hotel, Community Hall and St. Katherine's. Then three years ago (1975), the present Society were invited by the Ledbury Carnival Committee to again stage their Summer Show outdoors, with the Carnival supplying a marquee suitable to again stage a show, which Ledbury could be proud of. Their offer accepted, the show was back to its real home, having turned a full circle during the last 25 years or so. It is now hoped it will stay there for ever with the support of the people of Ledbury.

The society was known until 1957 as the Ledbury Garden Produce Club, when the name changed to the Ledbury Floral Society. This name stayed until 1976 when it was changed to the present name. The saddest year appeared to be 1971 when the Society lacked members and funds, now happily the Society thrives. In 1978, the Society has approximately 150 members and organise five shows throughout the summer, eight evening lectures throughout the winter and many other activates.

In 1977 the show attracted 750 exhibits, a record; this year, with your support, we hope it will be even better, so please come to the show and see the exhibits. There are classes for everyone: Flowers, Vegetables, Cookery, Handicraft, Photography, Wine Making, Floral Art and Children's Classes.

Finally may I on behalf of everyone, thank those who have donated so generously towards this year's prize fund, without whose generosity the Society would have to raise another £140 from funds to pay this year's (1978) prize money. Also all those who help in any way to organise the show, your offers of assistance are needed and very much appreciated

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

LEDBURY CARNIVAL Bank Holiday Monday 31st August 2015 STEP BACK IN TIME ENTRY FOR CARNIVAL PROCESSION

The Procession will start from Ledbury Rugby Club, travel up New Street to the Top Cross, through the High Street, along the Homend into Orchard Lane, finishing at the Primary School (1.6 miles). Entrants must arrive at Ledbury Rugby Club car park by 10am to allow time for judging and the procession to be marshalled for a 12.00 noon start. On arrival please book in at the desk.

The theme is Step back in Time Carnival, although you may choose a different theme for your entry. Safety on a float must be paramount, particularly if there are young children aboard, one person should be nominated as responsible for safety. Water pistols are not allowed. If you are able to have music of any sort on your float, it all adds to the day!! All entries will be provided with official collection buckets for raising money for the Carnival and local organisations, all buckets and any money collected must be handed to one of the marshals at the end of the procession. NO other collection buckets are permitted.

JUDGING – Entries will be judged under one of the following categories, and only one class may be entered by any one individual. There is also a prize of £50 for the best Child and Adult Fancy Dress.



Information for those who would like to take part in the procession

Safety Policy Statement

The Ledbury Carnival Association recognises and accepts it has a duty for providing, so far as is reasonably practicable, a safe environment for all who take part in, or attend, any carnival activity.

The Carnival Association considers that all persons taking part in the carnival accept and take their share in the duties and responsibilities contained within this policy statement and the provisions below.

Safety Policy Provisions

- 1. An adult representative of each entry must register with the committee and sign for receipt and understanding of these provisions. The representative will be the "responsible adult" for their entry and will enforce the following provisions.
- 2. The appointed "responsible adult" must not be the driver of any vehicle.
- 3. Pedestrian members of the procession must keep clear of motorised vehicles in the procession. Adults must accompany children to ensure that they maintain appropriate clearance.
- 4. It is the responsibility of the driver to ensure that any vehicle taking part in the procession is fit for that purpose. The Carnival Association reserve the right to exclude any vehicle it deems unsafe, but this does not remove the responsibility from the driver for ensuring safety.
- 5. Drivers are responsible for ensuring that all road traffic regulations have been met for the vehicle, e.g. Tax, MOT, Insurance, Fire Extinguishers, etc.
- 6. The driver must ensure that all fittings, e.g. scenery, chairs, podiums, etc. are attached or located such that they do not pose a risk to the people on the vehicle or any third party.
- 7. No passengers will hang feet over the edge of a vehicle side.
- 8. The "responsible adult" must ensure that no passengers on a vehicle approach the edge of the vehicle. Suitable ropes, holding points, seating or harness should be available for all passengers.
- 9. Any restraint system fitted to a vehicle must be "fit for purpose".
- 10. Motorised vehicles must attempt to keep moving at all times and must not exceed 5 miles an hour.
- 11. A smoking ban operates at all points in the procession. No e-cigarettes to be used where Children are involved on a float
- 12. An alcohol ban operates at all points in the procession. The Carnival Association reserves the right to exclude any person from the procession if in its opinion that person is suffering from the effects of alcohol.
- 13. A drug ban operates at all points in the procession. The Carnival Association reserves the right to exclude any person from the procession if in its opinion that person is suffering from the effects of any drug.
- 14. Any person taking prescription medication may only enter the procession on the advice of their Doctor. Where appropriate such persons must ensure that an adult, who is fully aware of their condition and any emergency actions that may be required, accompanies them.


